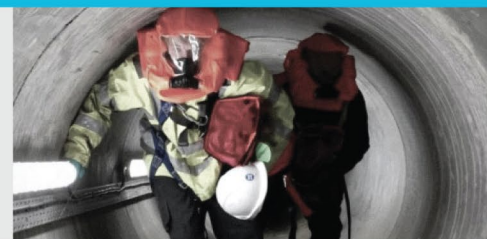


6160-03: Level 2 Award in Working in High Risk Confined Spaces



COURSE DURATION: 3 days

COURSE OVERVIEW

This qualification includes the 6160-02 module and then builds on this, enabling candidates to perform entries into high-risk environments where working breathing apparatus is required.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This qualification is suitable for operatives and supervisors alike who will be required to work in high risk confined spaces within the UK Water Industry or where a nationally recognised qualification is required. This also forms an essential step for any candidates wishing to move on to a full supervisory qualification.

PRE-REQUISITES

Candidates must have a clear understanding of both written and spoken English language. Interpreters can't be used.
Candidates must be clean shaven.

COURSE CONTENT

The course gives candidates knowledge and competence in the following areas in addition to the 6160-02 course:

- Overview of Compressed Air Breathing Apparatus
- Theory of Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA), looking at component parts and correct usage and maintenance
- Cylinder theory, including duration calculations
- SCBA pre-use checks, including donning and doffing procedures
- Airline Breathing Apparatus, covering theory aspects and pre-use checks
- Entry Control for Breathing Apparatus work
- Practical use of Working Breathing Apparatus in a High-Risk environment

QUALIFICATION

- Qualifies candidates to enter 'Medium and High Risk' confined space environments with compressed air escape breathing apparatus or working breathing apparatus as appropriate, and associated equipment
- City and Guilds accredited and certified
- Certification and ID card
- Valid for 3 years
